REGISTERING and CHECK-IN

12:00PM is check-in time.

You must be present and have your registration form completed and validated for the Halloween Costume Contest by 1:55PM to be included in the contest. No exceptions as we have a tight schedule to keep for everyone. Participants will be divided into the following competition categories: **Most Original, Scariest, Cutest, Funniest**; all entrants will be eligible for Best of Show and People's Choice awards.

COSTUME CONTEST RULES

- The Union Tourism Association Children's Halloween Costume Contest is open to children ages 0-14.
- Costumes must be self-contained. Connections to electrical sockets will not be available.
- Costumes will be judged on creativity, attention to detail, safety and the wearer's presentation. Extra credit will be given for costumes that are completely homemade.
- No costumes that would be banned in a "PG-13"-rated film will be allowed (it IS a Children's Halloween Parade).
- PRIOR YEAR'S COSTUMES that have participated in the Union Tourism Association Children's Costume Contest may not be used.
- Judges for the Halloween Costume Contest and their immediate family members are not eligible for the Contest.

JUDGING and AWARDS

- Judging will occur on October 30th. All entrants will have a chance to parade across the stage individually (or with a parent or guardian), have their name, costume name, and category announced.
- You will need to remain throughout the Costume Contest to be eligible for an award.
- The Halloween Costume Contest awards will be announced after all costumes have been exhibited.
- Upon being announced as a winner, you will be asked to march in the WINNERS section of the Halloween Parade. You may also be interviewed by representatives of 94.5 ROXY on-air during their live remote broadcast of the event.

IMPORTANT LEGAL INFORMATION:

- The judges shall have the sole authority and discretion to select the winners.
- All minors (those under 18 years of age) must have permission from a legal guardian to participate.
- By registering, all Halloween Costume Contest participants agree to let the Union Tourism Association use their images for promotional purposes, both photographs and video.
- Each entrant shall indemnify, defend, and hold the Union Tourism Association and its members harmless from any third party claims arising from or related to that entrant's participation in the contest. In no event shall the Union Tourism Association be liable to an entrant for acts or omissions arising out of or related to the contest or that entrant's participation in the contest.
